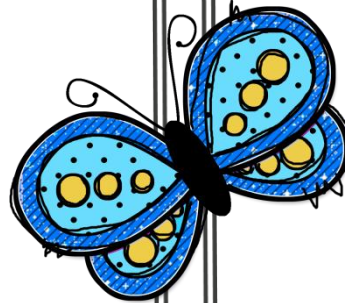

Protective Factors

Protective factors are skills, strengths, supports that promote resiliency despite the presence of risk factors (i.e. poverty, history of abuse or neglect, community violence, etc.)

Examples of protective factors: coping skills, supportive relationships (i.e. parental involvement) & social connections, academic skills, self-control, problem-solving skills, positive role models/mentors
